Dr. Mitra graduated from the University of Aberdeen, the UK in 2011. He did his postdoctoral training at the laboratory of Warren J. Leonard at the National Institutes of Health, USA. During his 5 years of postdoctoral training, Dr. Mitra worked in close collaboration with Prof. Christopher Garcia's lab using protein engineering tools to fine-tune interleukin-2 activity to mediate cell-type-specific functions.

Thereafter, in 2016, Dr. Mitra was recruited to the Research & Development unit of AstraZeneca, Sweden. In late 2018, he moved back to academia and was recruited to Prof. Bruno Quesnel's Inserm research team at the University of Lille as a research investigator. Dr. Mitra's research group focuses on understanding and exploiting synthetic immunotherapy-based approaches, such as CAR-T therapy in cancer.
