

I am specialized in the management of children and adolescents with leukemia. I have been appointed Head of the Pediatric Hematology Department at Saint-Louis Hospital in 1998. I then moved to create, by merging, the new Hemato-Immunology pediatric service at Robert Debré University Hospital since 2010, which I have lead until 2021. I coordinate the national protocol for the treatment of acute childhood and adolescent lymphoblastic leukemias (CAALLL-F01 and now ALLtogether). Since 2015, I have particularly involved in the development of CAR-T cells at the national and international levels, Robert Debré being the first pediatric unit to infuse CART cells to a child in France and participating to pivotal trials in the field.
