Jacques Nunès is a research director at Inserm and a board member of the French Society of Immunology (SFI). He holds a PhD in Immunology and completed two post-doctoral fellowships in London at the Imperial Cancer Research Fund (dir. Doreen Cantrell) and then in Marseille, at the Marseille-Luminy Immunology Center (dir. Bernard Malissen). He then joined Inserm at the CRCM research laboratories associated with the Regional Cancer Research Hospital, the Paoli-Calmettes Institute in Marseille.

Currently, Dr. Nunès is the co-head with Pr. Daniel Olive of the "Immunity & Cancer" team within the Cancer Research Center of Marseille (CRCM) affiliated with Inserm (U1068), CNRS (UMR 7258), Aix-Marseille University and the Paoli-Calmettes Institute. The team in association with the immunomonitoring platform, evaluates immune responses in patients with different types of cancer (Chrétien AS et al. PNAS 2021). It also proposes new strategies to optimize anti-tumor responses based on the study of intracellular signaling of cytotoxic lymphocytes (Celis-Gutierrez J et al. EMBO J. 2015; Bernard PL et al. JITC 2022).

The Inserm team is associated with the Carnot, CALYM and OPALE Institutes.

Dr. Nunès has co-authored over 100 publications in peer-reviewed journals.
