

Marion Subklewe is Professor of Internal Medicine with focus on Cellular Immunotherapy within the medical department for hematology/oncology at the LMU University Hospital Munich, Germany. She is Head of the immunotherapy program in hematology and the CAR T program at the LMU University Hospital Munich, leading an intermediate care unit and an early clinical trial unit as well as a large outpatient clinic for pts with acute leukemias and aggressive lymphomas. She is heading the lab for Translational Cancer Immunotherapy at the Gene Center Munich with focus on translational research in t-cell based immunotherapy. Her research is focused on understanding mode of action and mode of resistance of bispecific and bifunctional antibody constructs. Current research integrates an adapter CAR T-cell platform and combinatorial approaches in the setting of AML. She is speaker of the national "Harmonize MRD Flow" consortium and member of the ELN working group on MRD. She is Principal Investigator in I-IT trials in AML and ALL as well as in > 30 oligo- and multicentric C-IT trials in leukemias and lymphoma.
